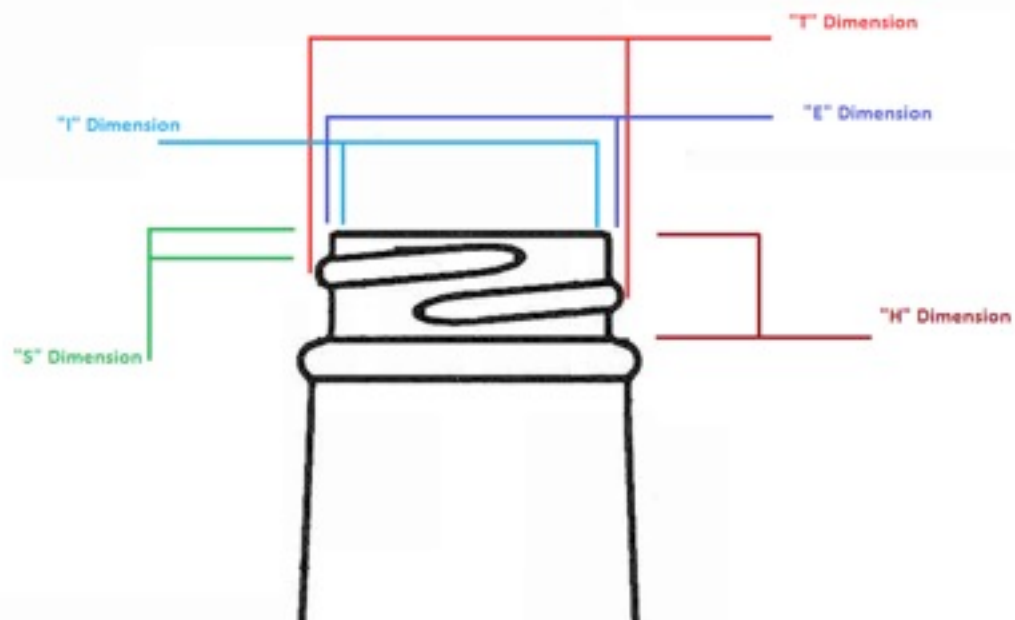


Technical Data

NECK & CLOSURE FINISHES

A container's neck finish (Top) determines the size and type of closure required to achieve a proper seal. A container and its corresponding cap must have matching finishes (Dimensions).



“T” DIMENSION

The outside diameter of the thread.

“I” DIMENSION

The inner diameter of the bottle neck. The throat of the bottle.

“S” DIMENSION

Thread start. Measured from the top of the bottle neck to the top edge of the first thread

“E” DIMENSION

The outside diameter of the neck (Root). The difference between the “E” and “T” dimensions divided by two determines the thread depth ($(E - T) / 2$).

“H” DIMENSION

The height of the neck finish. Measured from the top of the neck to the point where the neck intersects the shoulder or intersects the neck bead.
